

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN AGAINST COVID-19

14 MAY TO 16 MAY | FROM 10 AM TO 6 PM

The vaccination campaign against Covid-19 will be conducted at your place of residence (High-Deck-Siedlung, Weiße Siedlung and around Kiehlufer) from 14th to 16th May 2021. This vaccination campaign is a joint pilot project of the Senate and the Neukölln district authorities. The vaccinations take place in areas with a high occurrence of the virus.

The Johnson & Johnson and Moderna vaccines shall be used for the vaccination. Only one vaccination is necessary for the vaccine of the company "Johnson & Johnson". A second dose is required a few weeks later for the Moderna vaccine.

WHO CAN RECEIVE A JAB?

All persons 18 years and older who are registered in the following streets can receive a vaccination.

WHERE ARE THE VACCINATIONS ADMINISTERED?

The vaccinations are administered in the gymnasium of the school in Kölnischen Heide (Hänselstraße 6, 12057 Berlin). No appointment is necessary. Please be aware that extended waiting times are possible. You will need to wear an FFP2 mask.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO BRING WITH ME?

You have to live in one of the streets mentioned. This is why you need to bring your identity card and, if applicable, a certificate of registration. You should also bring your vaccination pass with you so that your vaccination can be recorded.

WHERE CAN I OBTAIN MORE INFORMATION?

The on-site staff will provide you with general information about the vaccination and Covid-19. Prior to each vaccination, you and the vaccinating doctor will have a personal informative talk. You can also ask any medical questions you may have.
